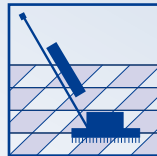
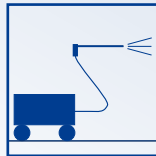


Desaster Clean

Applications: Neutral intensive cleaner - especially for fire damage restoration.

Desaster Clean is a pH-neutral cleaner that is suited for the restorative cleaning of all alkaline-sensitive surfaces. It is especially effective for cleaning greasy and sooty areas. Its working mechanism functions by encapsulating the dirt, enabling Desaster Clean to solve even the most difficult problems. Its special formulation prevents the penetration of soot particles deeper into the surface, which could otherwise lead to discolourations. Desaster Clean may be used with any cleaning method.

Desaster Clean is diluted 1:10 (1 litres with 10 litres of water) to 1:50 (200ml with 10 litres of water) and applied using the chosen method.
